Our Sustainability Commitments



Carbon Neutrality

Achieve carbon neutrality by reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions through renewable energy use, energy efficiency, and offsetting unavoidable emissions.



Promotion of Sustainable Practices

Encourage sustainable practices such as reducing single-use plastics, promoting sustainable transportation, and adopting environmentally friendly procurement.



Accessibility and Inclusivity

Ensure the event is accessible to all, regardless of physical abilities or socioeconomic backgrounds, with a focus on youth, women, and underrepresented groups.



Legacy and Continuity

Leave a positive legacy by supporting local sustainability initiatives and investing in long-term infrastructure and capacity building for ongoing climate action.



Transparency and Accountability

Maintain transparency in decision-making and accountability for commitments, with regular reporting on progress toward sustainability goals.



Collaboration and Partnerships

Foster partnerships with governments, organizations, civil society, and the private sector to address climate change and advance sustainability.




Safety for All

Carbon Neutrality

COP29 aims to achieve carbon neutrality by measuring, reducing and compensating unavoidable GHG emissions associated with COP29 operations.



Measure

The goal is to accurately **measure**, **monitor**, and **report** the carbon footprint of COP29 across all operational aspects, including direct (Scope 1), indirect (Scope 2), and value chain (Scope 3) emissions, ensuring transparency and enabling targeted reductions in GHG emissions throughout the event.

Reduce

Sustainable Mobility: Free metro, new micromobility lanes, electric shuttles, and hybrid/ electric taxi fleet for COP29 participants.

Energy Efficiency: Efficient lighting and appliances, energy management systems and regular energy audits in COP29 venues.

Renewable Energy: Use of renewable energy at COP29 venues: hydrotreated vegetable oil (HVO) and renewable power procurement.

Compensate

Compensation of Unavoidable Emissions:

Purchasing high-quality international carbon offsets and supporting local climate change mitigation initiatives in Azerbaijan.


